#### NOTIFICATION

The 18th June 2018

**SUBJECT**—Restructuring of the Cadres of Geological Survey and Exploration Wing, Mineral Administration Wing and Chemical Analysis Wing of Odisha Mining & Geology Services under the Directorate of Geology and Directorate of Mines.

No. 4715-SM.—Whereas, rapid industrialization in the State particularly that of mineral based Industries primarily because of facilitating policies of the State Government has led to manifold increase in mineral production;

And whereas, with MMDR Amendment Act, 2015, the Mineral Concessions of major minerals are to be granted through auction of only those blocks which have been explored up to at least G2 or G3 level. And this requires expeditious steps for exploration of virgin areas and also updation of exploration status for conducting auction. Similar provisions for auction in case of specified minor minerals have also been brought in Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016;

And whereas, the State Government have notified Odisha Mineral Exploration Policy, 2015 with an objective of realizing the potential of mining sector through scientific exploitation of mineral resources. The policy aims at strengthening the institutional set up for mineral exploration and to upscale the exploration activities;

And whereas, consequent to aforesaid developments, the work-load and nature of duties in the Geological Survey and Exploration Wing under the Directorate of Geology and also Mineral Administration and Chemical Analysis Wings under the Directorate of Mines have undergone radical changes over the years justifying restructuring of the cadres in these Wings of Administration to built up institutional and manpower capabilities of both the Directorates so as to enable upscaling mineral exploration activities in the State, conduct more effective mineral administration and enhance collection of mining revenue besides strengthening the Laboratory analysis of ores and minerals.

Now, therefore, the State Government, after careful consideration, have decided to restructure the cadres of Geological Survey & Exploration Wing, Mineral Administration Wing and Chemical Analysis Wing of Odisha Mining and Geology services and order as follows:

**A. Geological Survey and Exploration Wing under Directorate of Geology:**

- a. The sanctioned strength of the posts of Geologist is enhanced from 65 to 150 by creation of 85 more posts. Similarly, the sanctioned strength of the posts of Petrologists is enhanced from 2 to 10 by creation of 8 more posts and the sanctioned strength of the posts of Geophysicists is enhanced from 6 to 10 by creation of 4 more posts. All these posts which are part of a single cadre at Level-10 is upgraded to Level-12 of O.R.S.P. Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-2 with G.P. of Rs. 4,600 to PB-3 with GP of Rs. 5,400). These posts will continue to be filled up through direct recruitment only. Further, these posts created at the base level will be filled up over 3 batches having 1/3rd of the number in each batch.
- b. The sanctioned strength of Deputy Director of Geology is enhanced from 19 to 25 posts by creation of 6 more posts at Level-13 under ORSP Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-3 with G.P. of Rs. 6,600).
- c. The existing 7 (seven) posts of Joint Director Geology (Level-II) in Level-13 of ORSP Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-3 with GP of Rs. 6,600) and 2 (two) posts of Joint Director Geology, (Level-I) in Level-14 under O.R.S.P. Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-3 with GP of Rs. 7,600) are merged into a single grade of Joint Director Geology in Level-14 of ORSP Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-3 with G.P. of Rs. 7,600).
- d. One more post of Additional Director, Geology is created to enhance the sanctioned strength of A.D.G. to 2 posts in Level-15 under O.R.S.P. Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of PB-4 with G.P. Rs. 8,700).

The postwise existing and now restructured cadre is furnished hereunder in a tabular statement for Geological Survey and Exploration Wing under the Directorate of Geology.

**B. Mineral Administration Wing under the Directorate of Mines:**

- a. The existing 71 posts of Senior Inspector of Mines and 36 posts of Sr. Surveyor are merged out of which 21 posts are upgraded to the combined cadre of Assistant Mining Officer and Chief Surveyor. The strength of this merged cadre will be 86 (eighty-six). The merged posts are re-designated as Junior Mining Officers in Level-9 under Odisha Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised PB-2 with G.P. Rs. 4,200).
- b. The existing 14 posts of Asst. Mining Officer and 7 posts of Chief Surveyor are merged into one cadre and upgraded from pre-revised PB-2 with G.P. Rs. 4,200 to G.P. Rs. 4,600. Together with the upgraded 21 posts from the merged cadre of Sr. Inspector of Mines/ Sr. Surveyor, the revised cadre strength is 42 (forty-two). The posts of this merged cadre of Asst. Mining Officer and Chief Surveyor shall be completely promotional post from the Junior Mining Officer Cadre. The merged posts are designated as Asst. Mining Officers at Level-10 under O.R.S.P. Rules, 2017 (equivalent to pre-revised Pay Scales of P.B.-2 with G.P. Rs. 4,600).
