Bid security shall be in the following formats: The deposits have to be in India and may be in shape of—

- a. EMD/Bid Security, Fixed Deposit/TDR, on any Scheduled Commercial Bank/State Bank of India, NDC, NSC, Postal Savings Passbook, Post Office Time Deposit Account, Kisan Vikas Patra pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi.
- b. Additional Bid Security, Initial Security Deposit and Additional Performance Security Deposit, Fixed Deposit receipt from any Scheduled Commercial Bank, NDC, NSC, Postal Savings Pass Book, Post Office Time Deposit Account, Kisan Vikas Patra from any Scheduled Commercial Bank in India as per guidelines issued by Reserve Bank of India from time to time, pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II Duburi.

- c. Validity of the EMD in case of the successful bidder and Initial Security deposit (Performance Security Deposit) should be at least coterminous with the Defect Liability Period after completion of the work. Validity of Additional Bid Security and Additional Performance Security of the successful bidder shall be extended till completion of the work.

 - 1.6 The Financial Bid (Cover-II) consisting of the schedule of quantities of works is available in Website: www.tendersorissa.gov.in and the set of terms and conditions of contract and other necessary documents can also be seen in the said Website. Interested bidders may obtain further information, if any, at the above Website. The date and time of opening of Financial Bid (Cover II) will be intimated to the qualified bidders after evaluation of the Technical Bid (Cover I).
 - 1.7 The bid must be valid for a minimum period of 120 days from the last date of opening of bid (Cover-I). If any bidder withdraws his bid before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid, the EMD deposited at the time of submission of bid shall stand forfeited.
 - 1.8 No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor for a period two years after his retirement from Government Service, without Government permission.
 - 1.9 Other details can be seen in the bidding documents, which are available in Website : www.tendersorissa.gov.in.
 - 1.10 The original copy of CRC (Contractors Registration Certificate), GSTIN, PAN, Affidavit, VAT,EMD, Other documents and cost of Bid Document (the scanned copies of which have been submitted though website) should be produced in original to Chief Engineer,

JICA Project, BLB, Sukinda / Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi for verification from 20-02-2018 to 22-02-2018 during office hours before opening of Technical Bid as mentioned above, along with a set of Xerox copies duly signed by the bidders.

- 1.11 Non-submission of original documents at the time of verification i.e from 20-02-2018 to 22-02-2018 during office hours in time will make the tender non-responsive.
- 1.12 The Bid will be received through e-procurement portal from 10-00 hours on 02-02-2018 to 17-00 hours on 19-02-2018. Each set of bid document contains technical bid (Cover-I) and an intelligible bill of quantity (Cover-II). The cover-I bid will be opened as mentioned above in presence of the bidders or their authorised representatives, who wish to attend. The bidders who participated in the Online bidding can witness opening of the bid from any system logging on to the portal away from opening place. The bids can only be opened by the pre-designated officials after the opening time mentioned in the bid. In the event of the specified date of bid opening declared a holiday, the bid will be opened at the appointed time and location in the next working day. Date time and place of opening of Cover-II (Price bid) shall be intimated separately to those bidders who will be found eligible after evaluation of Cover-I (Technical Bid). - 1.13 The bidders shall prepare the documents and upload the scanned typed document in PDF format and BOQ in excel format (or as specified in the portal) in appropriate place.
- 1.14 No bidder will be permitted to furnish their tender in their own manuscript
- 1.15 For submission of bids through e-procurement portal, the bidder shall scan all the written pages of the bid security and cost of the bid document and upload to the system in designated place of the Technical Bid. The Online bidder shall have to deposit the "Bid Security" and "cost of the bid document" in original in o/o the Chief Engineer, JICA Project, BLB, Sukinda / Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi in the date & time mentioned in clause No 1.10 prior to opening of Technical Bid. Non-submission of "bid security" and "cost of bid document" within the specified period shall debar the bidder from participating in the Online bidding system and his portal registration shall be cancelled. His name shall also be informed to the registering authority for cancellation of his registration. Adjustment of EMD given with other tenders previously and submitted in other bids shall not be entertained. Jajpur or Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi, Dist. Jajpur (from 20-02-2018 to 22-02-2018 during office hours) prior to opening of technical bid. The officer inviting the Bid will not be held responsible for the non-receipt of the same with specified date & time.

The Bid Security of a Joint Venture shall be in the name of the Joint Venture duly signed by the authorised representative of the Joint Venture on behalf of the Joint Venture and shall be legally binding on all members as evidenced by a power of attorney signed by their legally authorised representatives.

- 1.16 The work is to be completed in all respects within 18 (Eighteen) calendar months including monsoon from the date of issue of work order.
- 1.17 The plans, specifications and scope for the work can be seen in the office of the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi during any working day.
- 1.18 The bidders shall carefully study the drawings and specifications applicable to the contract and all documents which will form part of the agreement, detailed specifications for Odisha and other relevant specifications and drawing which are available with the tender document or with the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi. Complaint at a future date that plans and specifications have not been seen by the bidders will not be entertained.
- 1.19 The bidder can resubmit his bid through online e-procurement mode, out of which the system shall consider only the last bid submitted to the portal.
- 1.20 Every bidder is expected before quoting his rates, to inspect the site of the proposed work. He should also inspect the quarries and approach road to quarries and locality of the work and satisfy himself about the quality and availability of materials including the medical aids, labour and foodstuff etc. In every case the materials must comply with the relevant specifications.

The bidder will be deemed to have satisfied himself that the rates quoted by him in the tender will be adequate to complete the work according to the specifications and conditions attached to it and that he has taken into account all conditions, difficulties that may be encountered during the progress of the work and to have quoted labour rates and materials, entry tax and other duties, leads, lifts, loading and unloading and freight for materials and all other charges necessary for completion of the work to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge of the work and his authorised subordinates.

- 1.21 Each bidder must quote a define rate for each item of work which will be included in the contract. Tenders containing indefinite terms such as estimated rates or schedules of rates or percentage basis will not be considered. Rates should be for finished items of work unless otherwise mentioned in the Tender Schedule. In case of any discrepancy between the rates in figures and words, the rate quoted in words is taken as correct. [Para. 3.5.11 Amended 1995 (b)-(iii)].
- 1.22 A pre-bid conference will be held in the office of the Chief Engineer, JICAProject, Brahmani Left Basin, Sukinda at 11-30 A.M. to 12-30 P.M. on 01-02-2018.
- 1.23 An intelligible BOQ in MS Excel format shall be made available to the bidder through e-procurement portal. The bidder shall download that particular excel sheet and fill in the rates in figures at the appropriate locations. The line item total in words and the total amounts in case of item rate tender shall be calculated automatically and shall be visible to the bidder. The bidder is not supposed to change or modify the format of the excel sheet in any form.
- 1.24 The bidder shall submit the documents in the designated location of Technical Bid (Cover-I) and Financial Bid (Cover-II). Submission of bid documents shall be effected by ensuing DSC of appropriate class and thus shall be in encrypted form. The bidder shall only submit single copy of the documents. He is required to check the documents uploaded with the requirement asked for in the bid. Only after satisfying that all the documents have been uploaded, he should activate submit button. His bid shall not be considered responsive and action as per relevant clause shall be taken if he does not provide the required documents or provides illegible documents. Clarity of the documents may be ensured by taking out a sample printing.
- 1.25 The bidder has to quote his rates for each items including all taxes, royalties, cess, income taxes and surcharge etc. (excluding GST) on works contract as applicable from time to time by the Government.
- 1.26 GST (TDS) will be deducted as per Govt. Notification from works bill as applicable from time to time.
- 1.27 All taxes, fees, royalties, cess payable under the local rule, income taxes & surcharges as applicable, etc. will be borne by the contractor as admissible. It is implied that the quoted rates are inclusive of such elements and accordingly the taxes will be deducted from the bill as admissible.
- 1.28 Tax invoice by the contractor: While submitting the works bill, the contractor will have to submit tax invoice as per Rule 46 of OGST Rule, 2017.

- 1.29 It is allowed to modify the bid through the e-procurement portal. The bidder shall have to log in the system and resubmit the documents as asked for by the system including the price bid. In doing so, the bids already submitted by the bidder will be removed automatically from the system and latest bid only will be admitted. But the bidder should avoid modification of the bid at the last moment to avoid system failure or malfunction of the internet or traffic jam. If the bidder fails to submit his modified bids within the scheduled time of receipt, the bids already in the system shall be taken for evaluation.
- 1.30 Withdrawal of bid is also allowed in the e-procurement portal. The bidder has to click on the "withdraw" button and record the necessary justification for the same in the space provided. In addition to this he has to write a letter addressed to officer inviting the bid and upload the scanned document from portal in respective bid. The system shall not allow any withdrawal after the deadline.
- 1.31 The e-procurement portal system shall reject submission of any bid through portal after closure of the receipt time. For all purposes the portal time displayed in the system shall be the time to be followed by the bidder.
- 1.32 The contractor shall have to furnish certificate along with the tender to the effect that he is not related to any officer in the rank of an Assistant Executive Engineer and above / Under-Secretary and above in the Department of Water Resources, Government of Odisha.
- 1.33 While determining the validity of tenders the following points shall be taken into consideration by the authority empowered to accept tenders and his decision in the matter shall be final:
 - (a) Any special condition which does not find place in the tender notice and which are not acceptable.
 - (b) Indefinite conditions which will make it difficult to assess the financial implication.
 - (c) Tenders being incomplete in some important aspects.
 - (d) Incomplete schedule of time for completion of the work.
 - (e) Failure to furnish the specified bid security.
 - (f) Tendered rates being unduly low and unworkable.
 - (g) Rates in different items of a tender being irrational.
- 1.34 The tender may not be considered unless accompanied by attested true copies of Registration of Firms/ S.S.I. Unit / EPM rate contract holder certificate, PAN Card, GSTIN Non-assessment Certificate as the case may be and the original certificates are to be produced on a subsequent date during processing of tender.

Attested true copy of work done certificate is to be furnished along with the tender obtaining the same from the Executive Engineer concerned.

- 1.35 The EMD will be forfeited in any of the following cases:—
 - (a) If the bidder withdraws the bid after bid opening during the period of bid validity.
 - (b) If the bidder does not accept the correction of the bid price.
 - (c) In the case of a successful bidder, if the bidder fails within the specified time limit to—
 - (i) Sign the agreement or
 - (ii) Furnish the required performance security and additional bid security, as applicable.
 - (d) If any of the statements, documents, certificates uploaded by the bidder through e-procurement portal, is found to be false/fabricated / bogus, the bidder will be black-listed and his EMD / Bid security forfeited.
- 1.36 The successful bidder shall within a period of 28 days from the date of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance with due regard to the validity of the tender make an initial security deposit of 1 % of the accepted tendered amount duly pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi in addition to the EMD earlier deposited.
 - The award of the contract letter shall be generated through the e-procurement system and the bidder shall be intimated in his e-mail address after acceptance of the bid, followed by Speed Post.
- 1.37 Bidder, whose bid is accepted must submit "programme of work" at the time of execution of agreement in prescribed format for approval of Engineer-in-charge.
- 1.38 The bidder shall sign as a token of final acceptance of the plans, sections with agreements for the work prior to take up the work for execution.
- 1.39 The date of commencement of work shall be notified in work order.
- 1.40 On signing the agreement the available site will be handed over to the contractor for execution of works.
- 1.41 The work may be split up and distributed among several contractors, if circumstances so demand, for timely completion of the work and the contractor is not entitled to any compensation on this account.
- 1.42 An affidavit shall be furnished by the bidder at the time of submission of tender paper about the authentication of tender documents including bid security. The scanned copy of the affidavit is to be uploaded through the e-procurement portal along with the technical bid. The affidavit in original is to be produced before the officer inviting tender prior to opening of the technical bid.
- 1.45 Additional performance security shall be obtained from the bidder when the bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender. In such an event, only the successful bidder who has quoted less bid price/rates than the estimated cost put to tender shall have to furnish the exact amount of differential cost, i.e. estimated cost put to tender minus the

quoted amount as Additional Performance Security (APS) in shape of Term Deposit Receipt pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer, Left Canal Division No. II, Duburi within seven days, otherwise the bid shall be cancelled and the security deposit shall be forfeited. Further, proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against bidder. (Amendment to Para. 3.5.5.(V) of Note-II of OPWD Code, Vol-I by modification as per OM No. 14299, dated the 3rd October 2017 of Works Department of Govt. of Odisha).

- 1.46 The lowest rate quoted by the bidder is to be treated as 1st lowest as it is an item rate contract.
- 1.47 If the rate quoted by the bidder is less than 15% of the tender amount, then such a bid shall be rejected and the tender shall be finalized basing on merits of rest bids. But if more than one bid is quoted at 14.99% less than the estimated cost, the tender accepting authority will finalize the tender through a transparent lottery system, where all bidders/ their authorized representatives, the concerned Executive Engineer and DAO will remain present (Vide Office Memorandum 12366/W, dated the 8th November 2013 of Works Department, Govt. of Odisha).
- 1.48 The bidders are requested to quote their rates inclusive of all taxes (excluding Goods and Service Tax (GST)).
- 1.49 Authority reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
