And whereas, the said Government consider it expedient to refer for adjudication the matters specified in the Schedule given below which appear to be the matters in dispute.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947), the State Government do hereby refer the said matter in dispute to the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bhubaneswar constituted by the Government of Odisha in the erstwhile Labour & Employment Department Notification No. 12198-LE., dated the 7th September 1995, read with Notification No. 6517, dated the 29th August 2016 for adjudication.

RESOLUTION

SUBJECT :— "Revival of lost ayacut & extension of ayacut in Major, Medium & Minor Irrigation Projects through Extension, Renovation & Modernisation (ERM) Activities."

The State is presently served by 64 major and medium irrigation projects with a canal network of around 18,100 km. That apart, 3,719 MIPs (Full functional 2,299 Nos, Partly Derelict 892 Nos, Completely Derelict 528 Nos.) under the control of the Department are also in operational condition. The combined designed ayacut of these projects is about 17.15 lakh hectares (Major & Medium 12.04 lakh hectares, MIPs 5.11 lakh hectares). Out of the above many projects were commissioned during 1980's & 1990's and have already rendered service to the State for more than 25 years. The normative fund allocated under non-plan for O. & M. activities is not adequate to keep these irrigation projects in healthy condition. The canal system mostly being earthen gets deteriorated during course of use. The structures viz. falls, CDs, regulators, outlets etc. are in dilapidated condition. Water use efficiency has been adversely affected resulting in less utilization of created irrigation facilities. The projects are now operating below their designed capacity.

It is estimated that out of 17.15 lakh hectares of irrigated agricultural land about 3.87 lakh hectares (Major & Medium 2.10 lakh hectares, MIPs 1.77 lakh hectares) are deprived of getting irrigation water either fully or partially. Farming Community /Pani Panchayat representatives in the deprived areas are regularly demanding restoration of canal systems for equitable distribution of water.

Besides, there are some major and medium irrigation projects which have the scope to provide irrigation to additional agricultural land beyond the designed ayacut. The development cost per hectare of creation of additional irrigation potential is relatively less in comparison to the new projects. More areas can be covered under irrigation with marginal investment.

Department of Water Resources is implementing renovation and modernization work of some selected projects through OIIAWMIP & OCTMP Scheme. Besides, some MIPs have also been renovated under RRR funded by Government of India. There are some projects which could not be covered under EAPs or other schemes due to limitations of their scheme guidelines.

In order to address the above problems in a holistic manner, the State Government has decided to launch a new State funded scheme with an outlay of Rs. 635.00 cr. for revival of lost ayacut and extension of ayacut of Major, Medium and Minor irrigation Projects through ERM activities. 14 major and medium irrigation projects and 284 MIPs have been included under the Scheme. The Scheme has been named as "Nabakrushna Choudhury Secha Unnayan Yojana" in fond memory of the great freedom fighter and former Chief Minister of the State. It will be implemented over a period of three years i.e. 2017-18 to 2019-20.

The salient features of the Scheme are enumerated below:

Scheme Objectives :

The scheme has three fold objectives:-

- (i) To revive the lost ayacut by restoring the irrigation system to its designed capacity.
- (ii) To increase irrigation area of some selected projects beyond designed capacity.
- (iii) Equitable distribution of water and full utilization of designed irrigation potential.

Scheme Components :

The Scheme has two main components i.e. modernization of canals and extension of canals with provision towards pre-project activities and physical and price contingencies as indicated in the following table:—

Implementation and Financial Arrangement :

The Scheme will be implemented through the existing set up of Department of Water Resources following the available standard arrangement and procedures. The Scheme having an outlay of Rs. 635 cr. will be implemented over a period of 3 years i.e. 2017-18 to 2019-20. The above outlay is proposed to be met out of State's own resources.

Expected Achievement :

- Revival of Irrigation potential 46,296 hectares
- Increase in additional irrigation coverage 8,719 hectares

This Resolution shall come into force from its date of issue.
