**S.R.O. No. 261/2023**—In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33 of the Odisha Forest Act, 1972 (Odisha Act 14 of 1972), the State Government do hereby declare that the following land situated in village Nuabaripal under Ghasipura Tahasil in the district of Keonjhar mutated and transferred in favour of Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department for raising Compensatory Afforestation thereon against the proposed diversion of 453.150 ha (including 136.150 ha of broken up area) of forest land for 3rd renewal of Khandbandh Iron and Manganese Ore Mines in Keonjhar Forest Division in favour of M/s TISCO Ltd., in Keonjhar District, Odisha vide ‘in-principle’ approval of Government of India, MoF&E (FC Division), New Delhi communicated in Letter No. 8-98/2004-FC, dated the 13th July 2005 under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the limits of which are specified below and the area of which is 76.67 ha (189.44 Ac.) shall be Protected Forest with effect from the date of issue of the Notification and shall be known as “Nuabaripal Protected forest” :—
