**NOTIFICATION**

No. 5963—TRN-LC-MISC-0065/2020-T.—Whereas, sub-rule (6) of Rule 90 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 provides that the other State vehicles holding National Permit shall not pick up and set down goods between 2(two) points in another State, if restricted by that State.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of Government that some other State vehicles having National Permit are picking up and setting down goods between two points in the State of Odisha causing financial loss to the vehicle owners of the State in this Covid-19 Pandemic Situation.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under the aforesaid rules, the State Govt. do hereby restrict the other State Goods Carriages having National permit for picking up and setting down goods between two points in the State of Odisha in Public Interest.
