No. 6251—Mon-SE-1/2016-WR.—In pursuance of the approval of the Project proposal "Conserve water through management of run-off in the River Basin to reduce vulnerability and enhance resilience for traditional livelihood in Nuapada" by Ministry of Forest & Environment, Government of India for Rupees 20 Crore under National Adaption Fund for Climate Change (NAFCC) and duly approved by Government of Odisha on the 19th February 2016, a Project Steering Committee is hereby constituted under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner-*cum*-Additional Chief Secretary, Odisha with the members of the committee as follows :

The Committee is constituted to oversee the Project Design and Implementation of the Project.

It is the matter of pride that this Project proposal is the country's first proposal under NAFCC and fund has been sanctioned for the Project with an objective to construct water harvesting structure, i. e. Check Dams in series or stand-alone basis in Upper Jonk River System to conserve water through management of run-off and utilizing the water, to reduce vulnerability of the population of the area in terms of increased water availability, better cropping and improved livelihood.
