### NOTIFICATION

The 22nd February, 2021

No.1695—TRN-LC-CASE-0006/2020/T.— The following draft of certain rules which the State Government proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 176 read with Section 159 of the Motor Vehicles Act., 1988 (59 of 1988) to amend the Odisha Motor Vehicles (Accidents Claims Tribunal) Rules, 2019 is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the said Act. for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration by the State Government on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the *Odisha Gazette*.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received by the Principal Secretary to Government, Commerce & Transport Department from any person in respect of the said draft before expiry of the period so specified above will be considered by the State Government.

### DRAFT

- (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Motor Vehicles (Accidents Claims Tribunal) (Amendment) Rules, 2020.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.
- In the Odisha Motor Vehicles (Accidents Claims Tribunal) Amendment Rules, 2019, in rule 3:-
  - in clause (d), for the words “Claims Tribunal” the words “Claims Tribunal and the Odisha State Legal Services Authority” shall be substituted;
  - after clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :-

“(e-1) upload digitally the documents specified in clause (d) in the Road Accident Case Documents Module developed by the State Crime Records Bureau, Odisha on Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and System platform

(CCTNS) and forwarded to the Claims Tribunal and the Odisha State Legal Services Authority which shall have access by the Claims Tribunal, Legal Service Authorities, Insurance Companies, Transport Corporations, owners and drivers of motor vehicles, kith and kin of victims and download the same free of cost”.
