RESOLUTION

SUBJECT—Restructuring of the Odisha Engineering Service Cadre of Water Resources Department.

Keeping in view the increasing workload, the stagnation in promotion and the resultant erosion in productivity in various Engineering Departments, the Cabinet in their 70th meeting held on the 26th February 2019, have decided to restructure the Odisha Engineering Service Cadre in respect of Water Resources Department, Works Department and Housing & Urban Development Department.

2. In pursuance to the decision of the Cabinet in its 70th meeting held on the 26th February 2019, and DoWR Resolution No. 6067, dated the 3rd March 2019, the restructured cadre of the Water Resources Department will be as follows :—

- (a) The total number of sanctioned posts of Engineering Service Cadre in respect of Water Resources Department has remained as 1608 as before.
- (b) The existing post of Deputy Executive Engineer in the Pay Level-12 has been abolished thereby resulting in the merger in the cadre of AEE & DEE.
- (c) The existing posts of Superintending Engineer (Level-II and Level-I) are being merged and re-designated as Superintending Engineer in the Pay Level-14.
- (d) A new post in the name of Additional Chief Engineer has been created in between Superintending Engineer and Chief Engineer in the Pay Level-16.
- (e) The Assistant Executive Engineers are to function as Subdivision Head and the Executive Engineers/Superintending Engineers are to function as Division Head. Circles are to be managed by Additional Chief Engineers. The Chief Engineers will remain as the Head of the Department as before.

- (f) All the posts proposed for upgradation covered under the proposal for restructuring shall be filled up strictly on the basis of seniority with exclusion of persons considered unsuitable.
- (g) The existing seven tier cadre structure as mentioned below has been modified to six tier cadre structure.
