NOTIFICATION

The 12th March 2024

No. 6460—HFW-MSIII-MSNG3M-0014/2023-H.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Odisha is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Odisha Radiographer Service (Methods of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2019, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement— (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Radiographer Service (Methods of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

2. In the Odisha Radiographer Service (Methods of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for the words “Senior Radiographer” wherever it occurs, the words “Senior Radiographer, Level-II” shall be substituted.

3. In the said rules, in Rule 9, in Clause (viii), for the words “have possessed valid Registration Certificate as on the date of advertisement”, the words “have possessed valid Registration or Renewal Certificates as on the date of submission of application form”, shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, for Rule 12, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“12. Eligibility Criteria for Promotion — The eligibility criteria for promotion in the Radiographer service shall be as specified in the Schedule.”.

5. In the said rules, in Rule 13, after sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely :—

“(2) The gradation list of Senior Radiographer, Level-II shall be prepared by the Director of Health Services for consideration of their promotion to the level of Senior Radiographer, Level-I after consolidating the districtwise lists.

(3) The gradation list of Senior Radiographer, Level-I shall be prepared by the Director of Health Services for consideration of their promotion to the level of Radiation Safety Officer after consolidating the districtwise lists.

(4) The gradation list of Radiation Safety Officer for promotion to the post of Assistant Director shall be prepared by the Director of Health Services.”.

6. In the said rules, in the Rule 14, in sub-rule (1), for the words “Senior Radiographer”, the words “Senior Radiographer, Level-II, Senior Radiographer, Level-I, Radiation Safety Officer and Assistant Director” shall be substituted.

7. In the said rules, for the “Schedule”, the following shall be substituted, namely :—
