### NOTIFICATION

The 19th March, 2021

No.9285—RDM-LAC-KNJ-0036/2017/R&DM.—Whereas, the preliminary notification under section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act., 2013 was issued by Government for acquisition of private land measuring an area of Ac. 0.29 in village—**Khuntapada**, P.S.- Keonjhar, under Keonjhar Tahasil of Keonjhar District vide Collectorate, Keonjhar Notification No. 170 dated the 23rd April, 2018 which was published in the Extraordinary issue of *Odisha Gazette* No. 1191 dated the 17th July, 2018 for construction of Daitari-Bansapani-Tomka-Jakhapura Doubling Raillink Project and declaration under section 19(1) of the Act in respect of the above schedule of land has not been issued till date;

And, whereas, as per sub-section (7) of Section 19 of the Act., where no declaration is made under sub-section (1) of Section 19 within twelve months from the date of preliminary notification, then such notification shall be deemed to have been rescinded. The second proviso to sub-section (7) of Section 19 provides that the appropriate Government shall have the power to extend the period of twelve months, if in its opinion circumstances exist justifying the same;

And, whereas, the Commerce & Transport (Transport) Department has requested with reasons to extend the period of twelve months and the appropriate Government is of the opinion that circumstances existed for the inadvertent delay;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by second proviso to sub-section (7) of Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act., 2013 (30 of 2013), the State Government do hereby

decide to extend the period off validity up to **31st July, 2021** for issue of Declaration under section 19(1) of the said Act.
