No.26619—HFW-AYUR-AYURM-0108/2016-H.—On recommendation of Odisha Public Service Commission, Cuttack, pursuant to Advt. No.01 of 2014–2015, Dr. Buddhadeba Mishra (UR), C/o Biswambar Mishra, At/P.O. Ankushpur, Via Kukudakhandi, Dist. Ganjam, Odisha-761100 is appointed temporarily as Lecturer in Group-B (Class-II) in the discipline of Shalya Tantra in the Scales of Pay of Rs. 9,300–34,800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4,600 with other allowances as sanctioned by Government from time to time subject to the stipulated terms and conditions.

2. On such appointment, he is posted at Government Ayurveda College, Balangir, Dist. Balangir.

3. The appointment is purely temporary and terminable at any time without any prior notice and without assigning any reasons thereof.

4. He will remain in probation for a period of two years with the condition that he should complete the probation to the satisfaction of the authority failing which his services will be terminated at any time in terms of provision of Clause (h) of Rule 13 of OCS (CCA) Rules, 1962.

5. The appointee should join in his place of posting within one month from the date of this Notification failing which his appointment shall be automatically cancelled.

6. The appointment is subject to his medical fitness to be determined by the Medical Officer not below the rank of CDMO and satisfactory verification of his character and antecedents. In case, any adverse report is received, the service of the appointee concerned would be terminated forthwith in accordance with the provisions laid down in sub-clause (ii) of Clause (h) of explanation under Rule 13 of OCS (CCA) Rules, 1962.

7. No TA/DA is allowed to join in the post.
