S. R. O. No. 626/2016—Pursuant to the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court vide No. 3, dated the 7th September 2016 in W.P.(C) No. 13814/2016 and order No. 3, dated the 28th September 2016 passed in W.P.(C) No. 14544/2016 as well as in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3, read with sub-section (3) of Section 4 and Section 149 of the Odisha Grama Panchayat Act, 1964 (Odisha Act 1 of 1965), the State Government do hereby declare that groups of contiguous villages of the Nayagarh District as specified in Column (4) of the Schedule given below relating to the Subdivision and Block specified in Columns (1) and (2), respectively to be a Grama by the name specified in Column (3) thereof and constitute a Grama Sasan for each of the said Grama.
