RESOLUTION

The 2nd March 2016

State Government of Odisha in the Forest & Environment Department vide Resolution No. 21048-F&E., dated the 14th December 2009, No. 20736-F&E., dated the 8th November 2012 and No. 721, dated the 11th January 2016 have imposed scrutiny fees for projects seeking clearance of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) under the Environment Impact Assessment Notification number S.O. 1533(E), dated the 14th September 2006 and the amendment thereof. Further the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India vide their Notification S. O. 190(E), dated the 20th January 2016 have constituted the District Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) to grant environmental clearance for Category 'B' Projects for mining of minor minerals.

After careful consideration, it is decided by the State Government that the following amendments shall be made in the above Resolution, namely :—

AMENDMENT

In the said Resolution, for paragraph 4, the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely :—

“4. The project proponents are to pay scrutiny fees in shape of Bank Draft payable in favour of the Chairman, State Environment Impact Assessment Authority at Bhubaneswar or Chairman, District Environment Impact Assessment Authority of the concerned district, as the case may be, at the time of applying for environmental clearance of the projects under the EIA Notification, 2006.”
