No.26526—HFW-AYUR-AYURM-0107/2016-H.—On recommendation of Odisha Public Service Commission, Cuttack, pursuant to Advt. No.01 of 2014–2015, Dr. Manjusri Sahoo (UR-W), D/o Sridhar Chandra Sahoo, At/P.O. Ratina, Via B. T. Pur, Dist. Balasore, Odisha-756115 is appointed temporarily as Lecturer in Group-B (Class-II) in the discipline of Prasuti Tantra in the Scales of Pay of Rs. 9,300–34,800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4,600 with other allowances as sanctioned by Government from time to time subject to the stipulated terms and conditions.

2. On such appointment, she is posted at Gopabandhu Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Puri, Dist. Puri.

3. The appointment is purely temporary and terminable at any time without any prior notice and without assigning any reasons thereof.

4. She will remain in probation for a period of two years with the condition that she should complete the probation to the satisfaction of the authority failing which her services will be terminated at any time in terms of provision of Clause (h) of Rule 13 of OCS (CCA) Rules, 1962.

5. The appointee should join in her place of posting within one month from the date of this Notification failing which her appointment shall be automatically cancelled.

6. The appointment is subject to her medical fitness to be determined by the Medical Officer not below the rank of CDMO and satisfactory verification of her character and antecedents. In case, any adverse report is received, the service of the appointee concerned would be terminated forthwith in accordance with the provisions laid down in sub-clause (ii) of Clause (h) of explanation under Rule 13 of OCS (CCA) Rules, 1962.

7. No TA/DA is allowed to join in the post.
