## The 31st January 2017

No. 197–C.—Whereas the State Government are satisfied that in the interest of Public, it is necessary to prohibit strike in the form of cessation of work by the workers engaged in emergency Medical Ambulance Service run by the Government either by itself or through an agency engaged for this purpose, so that health care delivery system in the State is not affected/disrupted.

Whereas as per Section 2 (b) of the Act, strike means the cessation of work by a body persons employed/engaged in any essential service acting ; in combination or a concerted refusal or a refusal under a common understanding of any number of persons who are or have been so employed/engaged to continue to work or to accept employment and includes unauthorized absence from duty in pursuance of a common understanding among the persons who unauthorizedly absent themselves from duty or under the direction of any other person or persons.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 3 read with Section 2 of the Odisha Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1988 (Odisha Act 9 of 1992), the State Government do hereby prohibit strikes in the cessation of work by the workers/crew members engaged for running energency Medical Ambulance Service run by the Governemnt either by itself or through an agency including 108/102 Ambulance Services. The order shall remain in force for a period of six months with effect from date of issue of order.
