## **NOTIFICATION**

The 6th April 2021

Subject—General Guidelines for issue of NOC to different institutions for opening Nursing, Paramedical or Allied Medical Science Courses and the different fees—Amendment thereof.

No. 10418—HFW-MEII-MISC-0071/2021-H&FW.—After careful consideration, the Government have been pleased to modify the following clauses of the guidelines issued earlier vide this Deptt. Notification No.26601, dated the 22nd October 2019 for issue of NOC in favour of different Nursing, Paramedical and Allied Medical Science Courses.

### Clause (iii):

Any Organization/ Trust/ Individual/ Society/ Central Govt./ State Govt./ Govt. Aided Institutions intending to open or start a institution to impart any course/ renewal of NOC must apply to the Registrar of Council online only and strictly as per the calendar of events and must have the minimum requirements. No application shall be submitted manually.

## Clause (v):

Scrutinization of application: On receipt of application, a scrutinizing team shall examine the applications and the documents enclosed. When the documents are in order as per requirement a letter shall be issued by the Council indicating that the institution shall be inspected for assessing feasibility for issue of NOC. In case of any deficiency, the Registrar shall inform the applicant in writing regarding such deficiencies and give a time of two weeks for compliance. In case of non-compliance wihin stipulated time the application shall be rejected and the applicant may apply afresh with fresh fees in next year after the floating of advertisement.

### Clause (vi):

Inspection and compliance: The applicant institution must fulfil the minimum requirements at the time of inspection. However as the NOC issued is valid for one year only, the minimum requirements for each year of curriculum may be considered as sufficient for issue of NOC for that year only. In case, deficiencies are observed by the inspection team, the Registrar shall intimate the applicant to comply within one week of time [or 30th November (for new

applications) and 31st March for renewal and enhancement] whichever is earlier. In case of non-compliance within stipulated time the application shall be rejected after giving opportunity to be heard in person within one week of time and the applicant may apply afresh with fresh fees in next year after the floating of advertisement.

## Clause (vii):

In case of applications for new course/ increase in intake of seats/ renewal of NOC, if the documents submitted are in order, the inspection shall be done as per above procedure laid down in Clause (vi) provided that the institution have submitted the non-refundable inspection fees.

## Clause (viii):

After verification of inspection report and being satisfied as per the existing guidelines, the Council shall recommend in clear speaking terms to the Government for issue of NOC. If the inspection report is found to be incomplete/ unsatisfactory, the case shall be referred for inspection afresh.

Further at any point of time before or after inspection, if it is found that the applicant has submitted forged or fake documents, the application shall be rejected and legal action deemed fit may be initiated against the applicant and the applicant shall be debarred to apply for next five years.

Rest of the guidelines for issue of NOC for different Nursing, Paramedical and Allied Medical Science Courses issued vide this Deptt. Notification No. 26601, dated the 22nd October 2019 remain unchanged.

This will be applicable in the whole State from the date of notification.
