RESOLUTION

SUBJECT—Selection of beneficiaries under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana for the FY-2016-17 onwards.

To ensure complete transparency and accountability and to eliminate corrupt practices from selection of beneficiaries under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana, Government in partial modification to the Notification No. 9508–17-BPGY-13-1001/2015-PR., dated the 9th June 2015, has been pleased to approve adoption of the following procedure for selection of beneficiaries under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana ;

- All houseless and households living in zero/one/two room houses with kuchcha roof and kuchcha walls as per SECC-2011 list, except the automatically excluded households, will form the universe of eligible beneficiaries.
- **2**. A household fulfiling any of the following 13 parameters as per SECC-2011 data will be automatically excluded.
 - (i) Motorised two/three/four wheeler/fishing boat
 - (ii) Mechanised three/four wheeler agricultural equipment
 - (iii) Kisan Credit Card with credit limit of Rs. 50,000 or above
 - (iv) Household with any member as a Government employee
 - (v) Household with non-agricultural enterprises registered with the Government
 - (vi) Any member of the family earning more than Rs. 10,000 per month
 - (vii) Paying income-tax

- (viii) Paying professional tax
- (ix) own a refrigerator
- (x) Own landline phone
- (xi) Own 2.5 acres or more of irrigated land with at least one irrigation equipment
- (xii) 5 acres or more of irrigated land for two or more crop seasons
- (xiii) owning at least 7.5 acres of land or more with at least one irrigation equipment
- **3**. The village and categorywise list of kuchcha households living in two or less rooms as per SECC-2011 list will be prioritized on the following principles :
 - Priority will be based on number of rooms in the order of houseless followed by zero, one & two rooms.
 - (ii) Within these groups, households that fulfill the criteria of compulsory inclusion will be further prioritized.
 - (iii) *Inter se* priority within the two groups viz. households which are compulsorily included and otherwise will be determined based on their cumulative deprivation score calculated from the parameters given below with each having equal weight:
 - (a) Households with no adult member between age of 16-59
 - (b) Female headed households with no adult male member between age 16-59 years
 - (c) Households with no literate adult above 25 years
 - (d) Households with any disabled member and no able bodied adult member.
 - (e) Landless households deriving the major part of their income from manual casual labour.

Higher the deprivation score, higher will be the ranking of the household within the sub group.

- 4. The system genereated categorywise ranked priority list of beneficiaries for each village should be downloaded and the households sanctioned with houses under any Government Schemes or rehabilitation measures will be deleted from the list.
- 5. The houses of remaining households in the list will be verified by BDO through field functionaries and those who have already constructed pucca house after preparation of SECC-2011 list will be deleted from the list.

- 6. Work order to the beneficiaries under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana (Normal) will be issued as per the target allotted in the order of ranking in the list.
- 7. The selection of beneficiaries under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana (Special) will continue to be the same as per the extant guidelines.
- **8**. The Appellate Committee constituted vide Letter No. 8744, dated the 20th May 2016 of this department will dispose of any grievance on selection of beneficiaries.
