RESOLUTION

The 29th December 2016

SUBJECT—Setting up of Project Monitoring Unit (PMU) in Western Odisha Development Council (WODC) under the administrative control of Planning & Convergence Department.

With a view to support the implementation of various projects sanctioned by WODC, to assess the quality of works executed by the Executing Agencies and also to prepare/examine the Detailed Project Report (DPR) and overall financial management, a Project Monitoring Unit (PMU) at WODC has been set up vide Planning & Convergence Department Resolution No. 6003-P., dated the 7th June 2013. The PMU has three components, viz., (i) Programme Management (to be headed by Programme Manager), (ii) Technical Support (to be supported by a Technical Consultant) and (iii) Accounts Management (to be manned by one Accounts Officer). The broad roles, qualification and experience, procedure of engagement and salary/contractual remuneration of the personnels of the PMU have been outlined in the aforesaid Resolution of Planning & Convergence Department.

In the meantime G. A. Department vide their Resolution No. 23750, dated the 27th August 2014 have come up with a comprehensive guidelines relating to engagement of retired government servants wherein the eligibility conditions and tenure of the retired officers to be re-employed have been prescribed.

In pursuance of G.A. Department Resolution indicated above, Government have been pleased to amend P. & C. Department Resolution No. 6003-P., dated the 7th June 2013 as follows :—

The stipulation of “below 62 years” imposed for the experience of Technical Consultant of PMU mentioned in Column (2) of the Table designed under Structure/Constitution of PMU in the aforesaid Resolution of P & C Department is deleted and the following condition in respect of tenure of engagement is inserted.

“The re-employment shall be made initially for a period of two years and can be extended for subsequent period of two years spells of one year each subject to satisfactory performance up to a total period of four years not beyond the age of sixty-five years of age in any case or till the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier”.

The Resolution shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

ORDER—Ordered that the Resolution be published in the extraordinary issue of the *Odisha Gazette* and copies thereof be forwarded to the Government in Planning & Convergence Department/ other Departments of Government/Chief Executive Officer, WODC/Accountant General (A&E), Odisha, Bhubaneswar for information.
